

The following are some places where dogs are permitted. Owners should carry water for their dogs as well as themselves. *Dogs must be leashed at all times except in enclosed dog park areas, and the owner must clean up after them.*

Rillito River and Santa Cruz River Trails (“The Loop”) There are watering stations set up for dogs wherever there is a water fountain for humans.

Saguaro National Park Dogs are permitted on all park roads and picnic areas but are not permitted on any trails.

Catalina State Park Dogs are not allowed beyond the park boundaries.

Tucson City Parks Operates a number of enclosed dog parks where dogs may be off leash. Udall Park is the closest one to Sabino Canyon.

Pima County Parks Operates a number of enclosed dog parks where dogs may be off leash. Most open space and natural resource parks do not allow dogs on the property (such as Tucson Mountain Park).

Santa Catalina Ranger District Dogs are not permitted in the Sabino Canyon Recreation Area, or the Bighorn Sheep Management Area (see Go Guide). They are permitted on other trails on Mt. Lemmon, and must be leashed.
